Manufacturing date range from 01/07/20 up to and including 13/07/20

**Dairy Chocolate Balls**, 300 grams package

"Best before" date range from 28/10/20 up to and including 4/11/20

Manufacturing date range from 01/07/20 up to and including 13/07/20

Consumers in possession of these products are urged not to consume them.

Anyone in possession of these products is asked to contact the Manufacturer at 053319489 to arrange for a refund or replacement.

Listeria monocytogenes are bacteria which may cause sickness in high-risk populations such as the immunosuppressed or the elderly and may induce miscarriage in pregnant women.
