Natalie Plus Ltd. wishes to inform its customers

that as the result of tests by the food services at the District Health Bureau in Haifa, there is suspicion of the presence of Listeria Monocytogenes in a “Red-headed” strip cake – “layers of delicate flake pastry with French vanilla cream and a touch of honey”, weighing 600 gr, with a production date of Dec. 13, 2017 and a last date of use of Jan. 18, 2018. Some 400 cakes were distributed.

“Natalie Plus Ltd.” has announced a recall of this product from the shelves.

The Listeria Monocytogenes bacteria is a bacterium that may cause illness in high-risk populations, such as those with weakened immune systems and the elderly, and may cause miscarriages in pregnant women.
